For the first time the candidature of an International FCI working title and CACIT at herding will be awarded. Only dogs which are registered at a FCI stud book are allowed to compete for this title. In order to obtain the title it is necessary to be graded with an "excellent" at trial class 3. The awarding of CACIT is not automatically linked to the obtained ranking

INTERNATIONAL WORKING CHAMPIONSHIP FCI

Only breed of dogs bin ich mir auch nicht ganz sicher ob hunderasse breed of dogs heißt oder ob es da nen eigennamen auf englisch gibt) which are allowed to

participate in working tests under the patronage of F.C.I. are allowed to compete for this title.

To be able to get the title International Working Championship a dog must have received:

- Regardless to the age, the dog must have two confirmations of candidature of the International Working Championship (CACIT), which are attained by two different judges, two different countries or two different National Associations. These two CACIT have to go along with two first rankings at International Working Tests under the patronage of FCI.
- At the age of 15 month the dogs have to attend an International *Exposition* at Working Class, Intermediate Class or Open Class and regardless the number of exposed dogs they have to get the qualification excellent or in countries which do not know these qualification they have to get the second position.

Austrian Champion

The winner at Class1 and Class 2 gets the title "Austrian Champion" and the winner at Class 3 the title "Austrian National-Champion". Only the best seeded participants who have their fixed domicile in Austria and are members of one of the corporate federation, which are in charge of the ÖKV, will be able to get the title.

The dogs will be judged by the FCI examination regulations for working dogs trials.

An activity book and a vaccination card with valid rabies vaccination is compulsory for all participants. The entry fee has to be paid at time of registration.

Participants from foreign countries are very welcome.

At Trial Class 3 there might be a double Outrun.

Entry Fee per dog and run: € 15,-

Food and beverages are provided.
